

# OUR Grants for CWU Undergraduate Students

## GRANTS OFFERED

### foundry10 Grants

- foundry10 Faculty-Student Research Grant (Winter) – \$3,000
- foundry10 Presentation Grant – \$1,000
- foundry10 Experiential Research and Immersive Studies in the Arts Grant – \$1,000

### Office of University Student Research Grants

- OUR Faculty-Student Provost Research Grant (Fall) – up to \$3,000
- OUR Presentation Grant – up to \$750 (Individual); up to \$1,300 (Group)
- OUR Experiential Research and Immersive Studies in the Arts Grant – up to \$750 (Individual); up to \$1,500 (Group)
- OUR Research and Creative Scholarship Grant – up to \$750 (Individual); up to \$1,500 (Group)

### Eligible Expenses

Funding can be used for conference registration, materials/supplies, equipment (will remain property of the university), transportation, travel, and more.

## APPLYING FOR OUR GRANTS

### Preparing Your Application

- OUR only accepts applications submitted via our online forms.
- Review the application guidelines for the specific grant(s) for which you are applying. All applications require documents in addition to:
  - Grant proposal; itemized budget with justification; and approval from the Human Subjects Review Council (HSRC), Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), and/or a completed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) if applicable.

### Grant Receiver Responsibilities

- E-mail OUR (our@cwu.edu) an impact letter summarizing your project progress, findings, and accomplishments by June 1.
- Use all funds awarded and submit your expense report (ER) within two weeks of final expense, but no later than 6 months after travel and before June 1 for reimbursement.
- Attend/Support SOURCE and SOURCE-related events as a volunteer or presenter.
