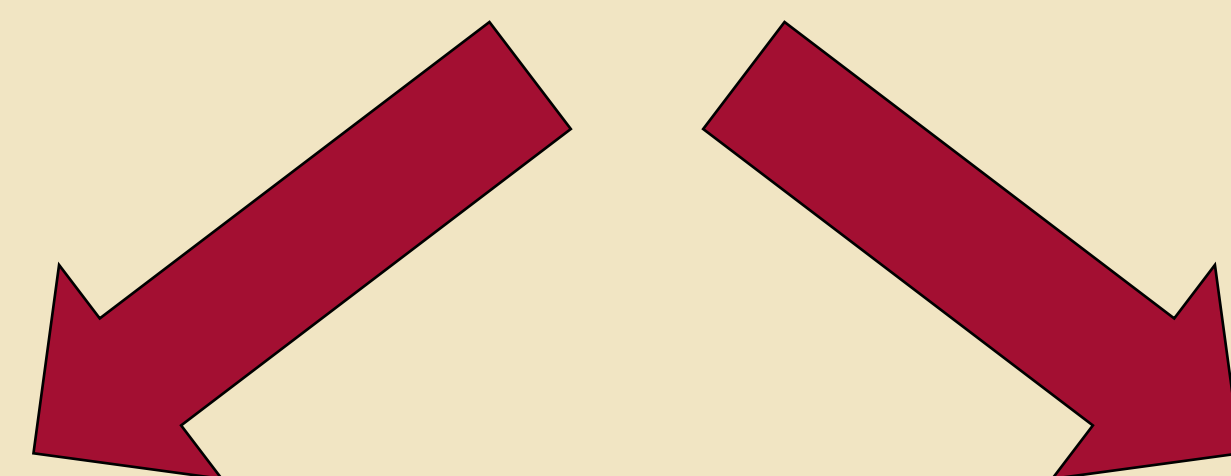


# Funding Opportunities for Graduate Student Research & Creative Activities

## School of Graduate Studies and Research (SGSR)



The SGSR offers **2 competitive award programs** to graduate students who meet certain eligibility criteria.



### Research or Creative Activity Support Award

- **Up to \$1,000** (paid by reimbursement)

#### Fall & Spring Quarters

- **Fall deadline:** November 18, 2025, by midnight
- **Spring deadline:** April 7, 2025, by midnight

#### Eligible Expenses

- Research or creative activity supplies and equipment
- Nonretroactive travel (to complete project)

#### Application Materials

- Cover sheet, abstract, project description, references, itemized budget (templates provided), CV/resume, appendix (if applicable)

#### Final Report

- Summarize project results and list any publications that resulted from the award.

### Graduate Student Summer Fellowship

- **\$3,500** (paid as federally taxable lump sum)

#### Spring Quarter

- **Deadline:** April 7, 2025, by midnight

#### Eligible Expenses

- Funding may be used at the discretion of the recipient to support research or creative activities that contribute to the completion of the thesis, creative project, or portfolio review

#### Application Materials

- Cover sheet, abstract, project description, references, CV/resume, appendix (if applicable)

#### Final Report

- Summarize project results and list any publications that resulted from the award.

### Applicant Eligibility

- Graduate students must be in good academic standing pursuing a thesis, project, or portfolio review.
- Applicants must have an approved Graduate Committee and Option Approval Form on file with the SGSR.
- Proposal must be endorsed by the graduate committee chair.
- Approval from the Human Subjects Review Council (HSRC) or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), if applicable.
