Course Equivalency Guide for Running Start Classes

Easton School Graduation Requirements	CWU Class Options	MET
English Junior/Senior	ENG 101 , or any course in the English or Communication Dept. above the 100 level . Students who intend to complete 11 th and 12 th grade English through RS must take Eng. 101 AND one other course above that level. <i>**It is recommended that students take an English course in BOTH their junior and senior years.</i>	
Fine Arts	Multiple course equivalencies; Any 100 or 200 Art , Music , or Drama class	
Math	Math 101 , Math 102 , Math 130 , Math 164 *Need placement test to qualify	
3 rd Year Math	Math 153 , Math 154 , Math 170 , Math 171	
U.S. History	HIST 143 , HIST 144	
Civics/CWP	ECON 101 , 102 , 201 , OR POSC 101 or POSC 210 (SOC 101 , GEOG 101 =CWP)	
Washington State History	History 301 Pacific Northwest History (if needed)	
Health/ Physical Education	HED 101 , NUTR 101 3 credits PE = semester credit/5 credits PE = year credit	
Science	GEO 101 , BIO 101 , CHEM 111 , CHEM 181 , BIO-ANTHRO 110 *Some are 4 credits + 1 Cr. Lab	

CTE	Multiple course offerings, verify with EHS counselor	
Foreign Language	Spanish Heritage language courses by placement - 261 , 345 . Various other languages	
High School and Beyond Plan (required)	Univ. 101 , 103 , or 301 OR may be completed at Easton School-online	
Electives	Any college-level classes not required for a specific High School graduation requirement will earn elective credit at the HS.	

Updated November 2022

- It is the student's responsibility to verify that they are meeting graduation requirements while enrolled in Running Start. Students should meet regularly with their high school counselor each term regarding high school graduation requirements.
- For purposes of transcript credits conversion, Easton School will allow .2 Carnegie Units for each one (1) credit. Example: 5 CWU credit class = 1 Carnegie Unit or Easton 1.0 credit.
- College coursework of any kind (Running Start, enrichment) must have advanced approval of the Principal or Counselor in order to qualify for Easton School credit towards graduation.
- NOTE: English 101 must be taken and passed with a C- or better before ANY other CWU English course. This is a Central Washington University requirement.
