No Show Policy

Federal, State, and CWU Aid

When a student with federal, state, and/or CWU aid fails to begin attendance in enough credits to match their award level, we are required to recalculate their aid eligibility for the quarter based on the number of credits they are participating in.

Any reduction in federal, state, and/or CWU aid results in funds being removed from the student's account and returned to their source.

How No Show Status is Determined

A student is considered a No Show in a class if they are assigned a grade of NS (No Show) by an instructor or if an instructor notifies Registrar's that the student is a No Show and Registrar's drops/withdraws the student from the class.
